1. Chair's Welcome and Report

Lloyd Burnell welcomed all members. Apologies were received.

LB reported that the club was now at end of its 6th season with some 200 players making it one of the largest, best established and respected clubs in the region.

All teams had done creditably well with the u12s and U18s second in their league. The two u12s teams played each other in the GFA Cup Final. The U13 team won their league and the split league. The First Team also made it to the Cup Final. This season saw the establishment of the U18s, with 5 players being called upon to play in the First Team, joining a number of players who had already come up from last season's Reserves. There has been a large influx of girls into U7, 8 and 9s. This demonstrates the growing success of the club's player development pathway.

Next season there will be a new U10 team entering BGL. The club welcomes Bristol Santos joining at U16 age group. Last season's U18s team are becoming the Development Squad in the Gloucester County Women's League. There are continued opportunities for players from U18s and Development Squads to progress to First Team. The focus is on developing coaching skills in the club and player development.

LB offered great thanks to all of the officers, volunteers and coaches for their time and dedication given to club. Out-going coach U16s Ewan Cameron is the club's longest serving coach and so LB thanked him in his absence for all his hard work and dedication over the years. The new coaches who joined this season had very positive first seasons — Rich Chaplin (U11s), Steve Price (U13s). Paul Blenkinsopp took over the running of the First Team very successfully mid-season, so tremendous thanks to him and all the coaching team across the club.

LB continued by thanking all the officers and acknowledged new officials this year: Julie Allison, as CWO, and Sandra Freke, as Registrations Secretary. Special mention was given to Rich Cowley, Vice Chair and U18s Coach for his huge support.

Thank you to Sarah Harris who has offered her support as Events Officer. More volunteers are still needed. Parents/players should be encouraged to come forward so that we can continue to support the development of players in the club and improve our standards of club administration. Current vacancies are: Fundraising Coordinator, Referee Coordinator and Kit Manager.

LB thanked all players, parents and carers for their continued support.
