12. Junior Section	U9s – 20 girls - with new girls joining each week. Still training at Coombe Dingle.
Report	U10s – 10 players. 1st game lost 2nd drew. The team looks promising. Action: DC to contact ML re goalie top. U11s - 16 girls - one who wants to train only. No games yet. U12s – 13 players. Game with Hanham cancelled at short notice will claim points. Love playing at Hallen FC although girls are getting tired because of bigger 9 aside pitch. Positive about the future. U13s – 20 players. 1st game lost 2nd won. Away fixture might be a problem in the Somerset Cup as it is a 140 mile round trip. U14s – U13s moved up. Struggling on 11 aside pitch - first match lost. Issue for next year will be numbers. U15s – 21 girls who are very keen. Won 1st game – eight in league. Teething problems with pitches at Coombe Dingle they are dealing with this. Action: AW to ask if any girl from U15s would want to move up to the U16s. U16s – 13 players. One girl injured and one has left. Lost 1st game won 2nd. Pitch has been poor at Coombe Dingle they are dealing with the problem. U18s – 23-25 girls. Two divisions jump. Issue with selections – girls beginning to understand. 1st game lost – looking positive for the next few games. The 16 years olds will struggle because of the big step up. Thanks to RB for doing a great job as the secretary.
